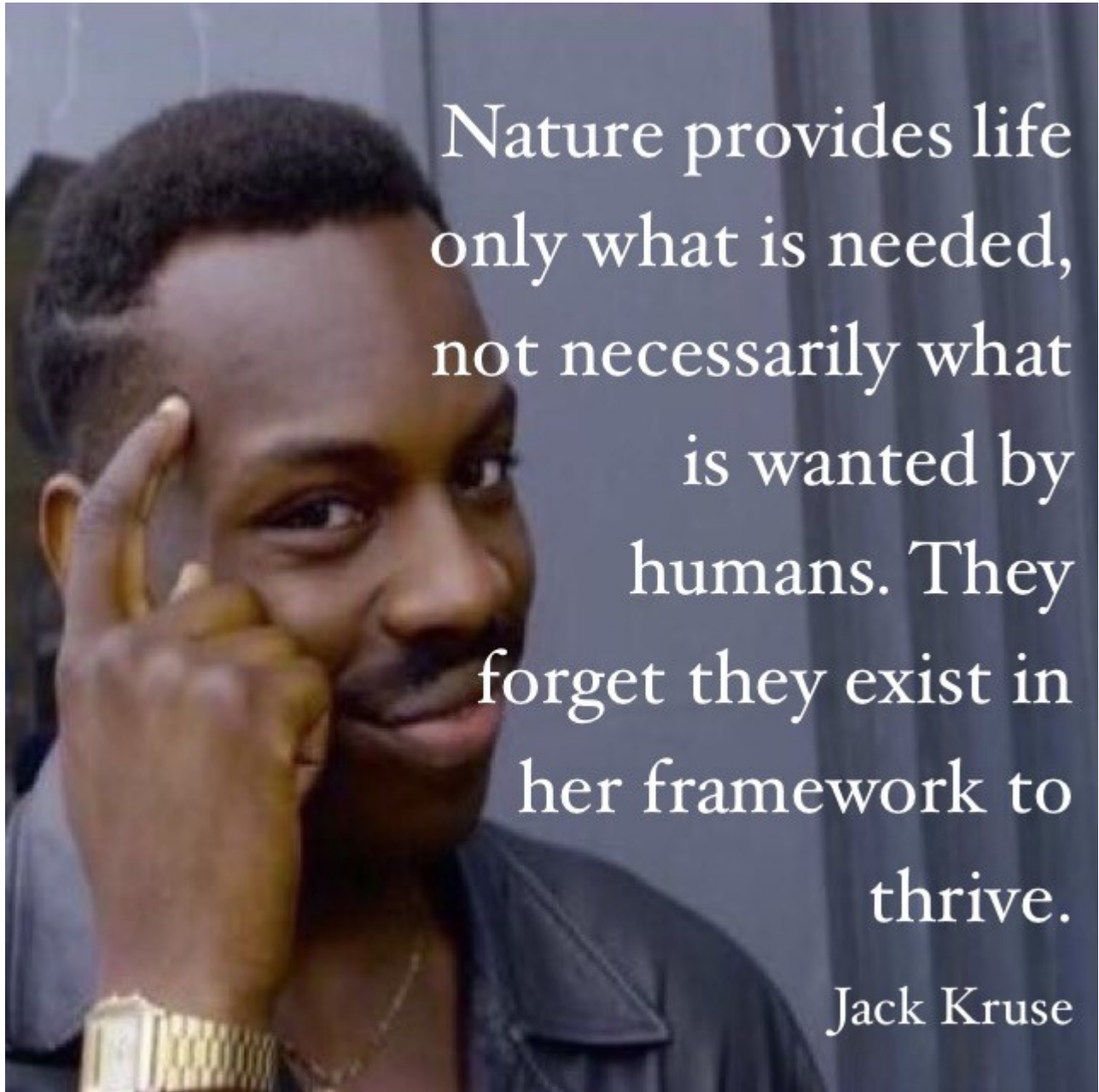


CPC #17: Will Coffee Be Wise in a 5G World?
