

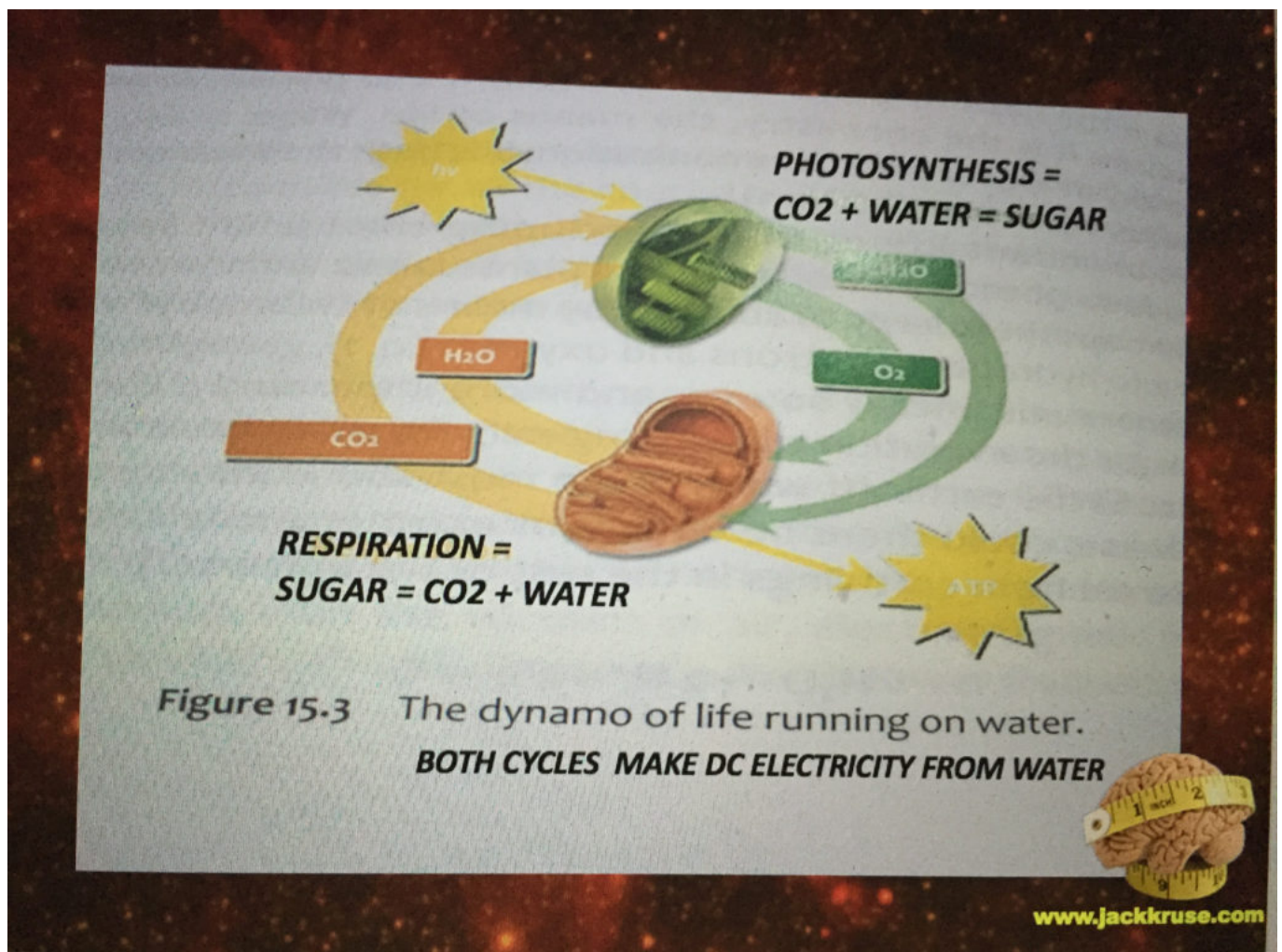
QT #21: Does Mitochondrial Water have a memory?
