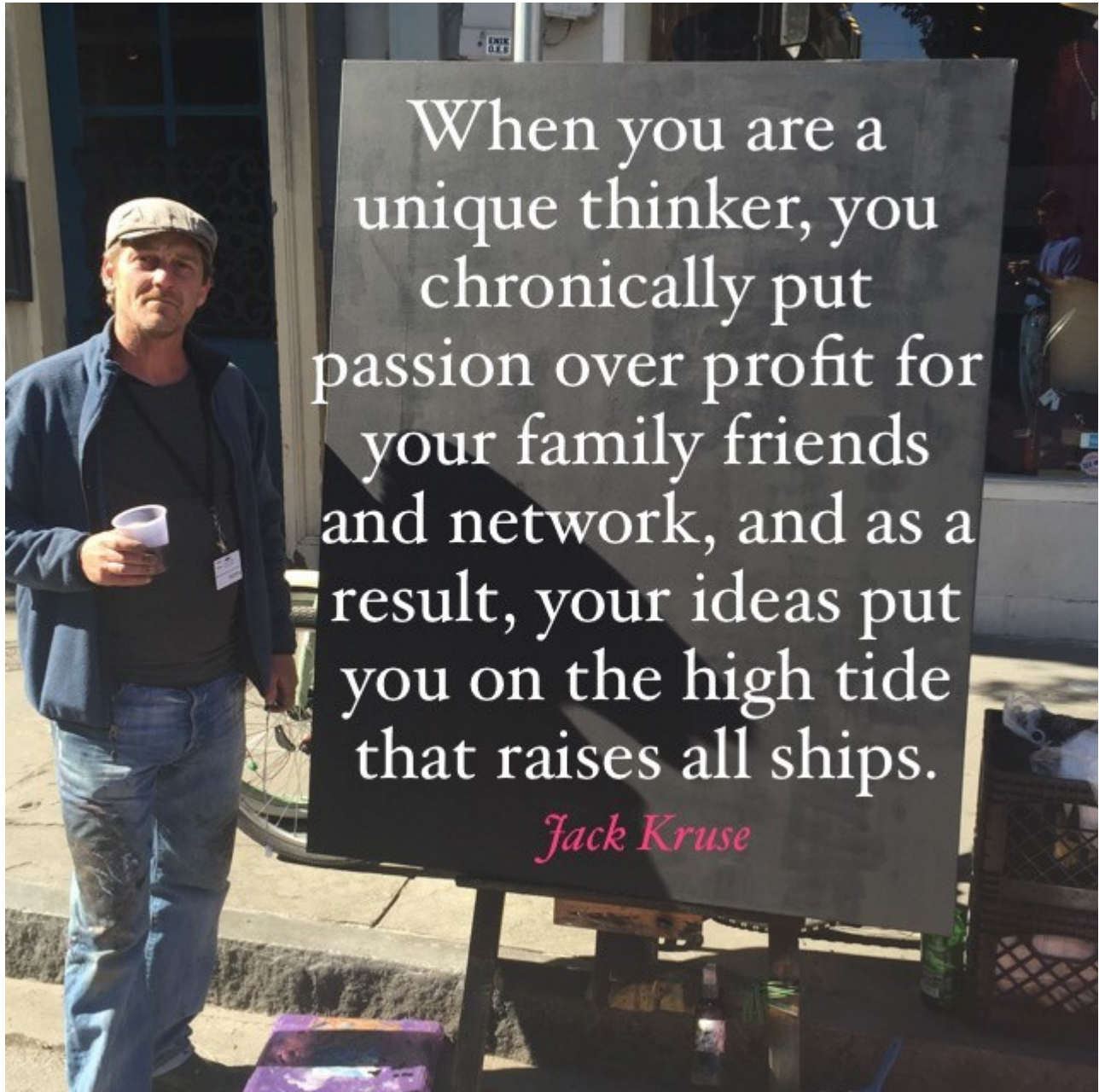


What the TSA Taught Me to Hack in Airports
